Terms and Conditions for Stall Holders

1. All booking forms must be accompanied by the full booking fee before any site allocation can be confirmed.
2. All cheques must be made payable to Hanwell Carnival & Show
3. All stalls holders are asked to respect others and limit the noise on their stalls unless other wise agreed with the committee
4. If exhibitors fail to turn up by 11.00 am on the day of the show and have not informed the parks organisers, the committee reserve the right re-allocate the pitch
5. Site allocations cannot be guaranteed upon request but the committee endeavour to allocate the space as requested.
6. All cars without an authorised parking permit must be removed from the park by 12.00 noon in time for the Carnival to commence. Unauthorised vehicles will be asked to leave immediately.
7. Exhibitors are requested to take ALL their litter generated from the show to the skips provided throughout the park or take it away with them. Under no circumstances must rubbish be left on your site after the show closes, failure to do this may prevent you from being considered for future shows. If you are unable to locate a skip please ask at the information tent at the park entrance.

General information

ACCESS TO THE SHOWGROUND

The showground is situated in Elthorne Park, Boston Road, Hanwell, London W7. Vehicle access to and exit from the showground for exhibitors will be via the lane adjacent to St Thomas's Church Hall. All exhibitors will only be allowed into the park if displaying a valid site permit ticket, which should be placed in the windscreen of your car.

SETTING UP, DISMANTLING AND MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES

Exhibitors may commence setting up stalls, sideshows and stands after 2.00 pm on Friday prior to the show. All stalls, side shows and stands must be set up and ready to trade 12.00 noon on the Saturday of the show. We recommend where possible, exhibitors should set their displays up either on the Friday afternoon as security will be on site over the Friday evening, but all props left will be at your own risk and not the Carnival's responsibility or alternatively set up early on the Saturday morning to avoid congestion or delay. The park will be open from 8:00am on the day of the show. All drivers are asked to carefully use the park roads where available to drive on and not drive across the field, crossing over onto sites.

Due to the development of the park extension area parking this year will be within a designated area of the park. This means that spaces will be limited. Only vehicles with an authorised parking permit will be allowed to remain. **NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE MOVED UNTIL 6.00PM.**
