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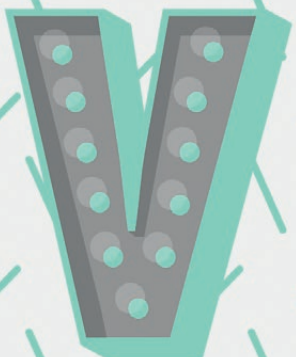

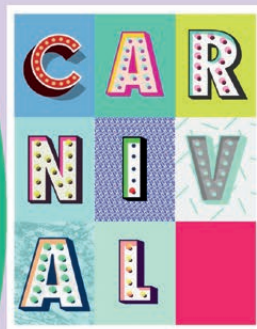
We Missed You Did You Miss us Too?

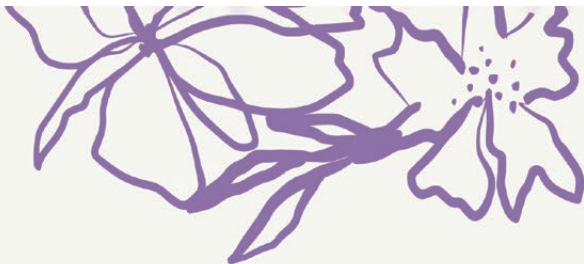

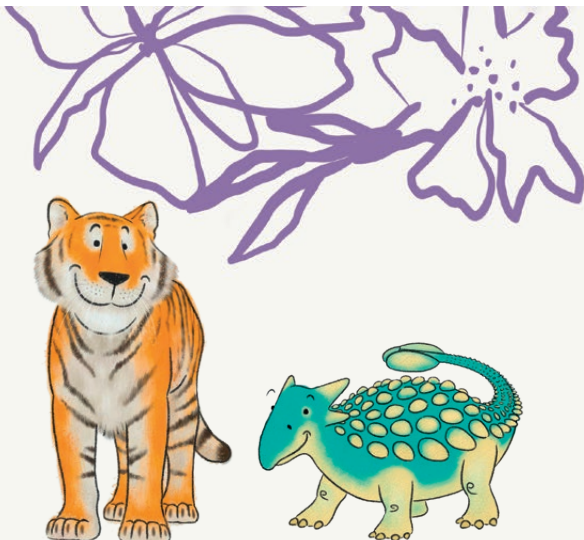

Did you ever meet a youngster who didn't know more about animals than you do?

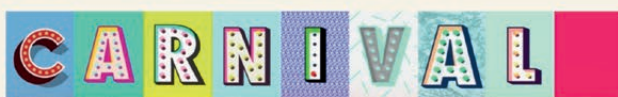

Hanwell has always known how to celebrate itself, and the story of the Hanwell Carnival proves it. It all began in 1898 with a glowing cycle parade through Elthorne Park, raising money for the Cottage Hospital and sparking a tradition of community pride.

Over the decades, Hanwell kept the momentum going with pageants, sports days, band festivals, garden parties and colourful processions that brought neighbours together and supported local causes. The big revival came in 1961, when showman Billy Smart helped relaunch the event with 46 floats, thousands of visitors and even a brand-new Mini Cooper raffled off to one lucky local.

Since then, everything from bonny baby contests to wrestling matches has added to the fun. After the recent pause, we're so happy to be back with the carnival this year — supporting, celebrating and showing off the brilliant community spirit that has always made historic Hanwell something to be proud of.

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Beating The Bounds

Every year a group of Hanwell residents meet up on the first May bank holiday to follow the ceremonial boundaries of Hanwell. It is a ceremonial event to make sure that our dastardly neighbours in Greenford, Ealing and Greenford have not been tampering with our proper and sacred boundaries. While this may be interpreted as an archaic and eccentric practice (which it is), touching each boundary stone with a willow twig has become something of a tradition which Hanwell Carnival is happy to support. 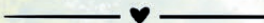

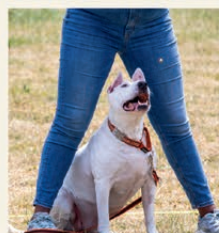
